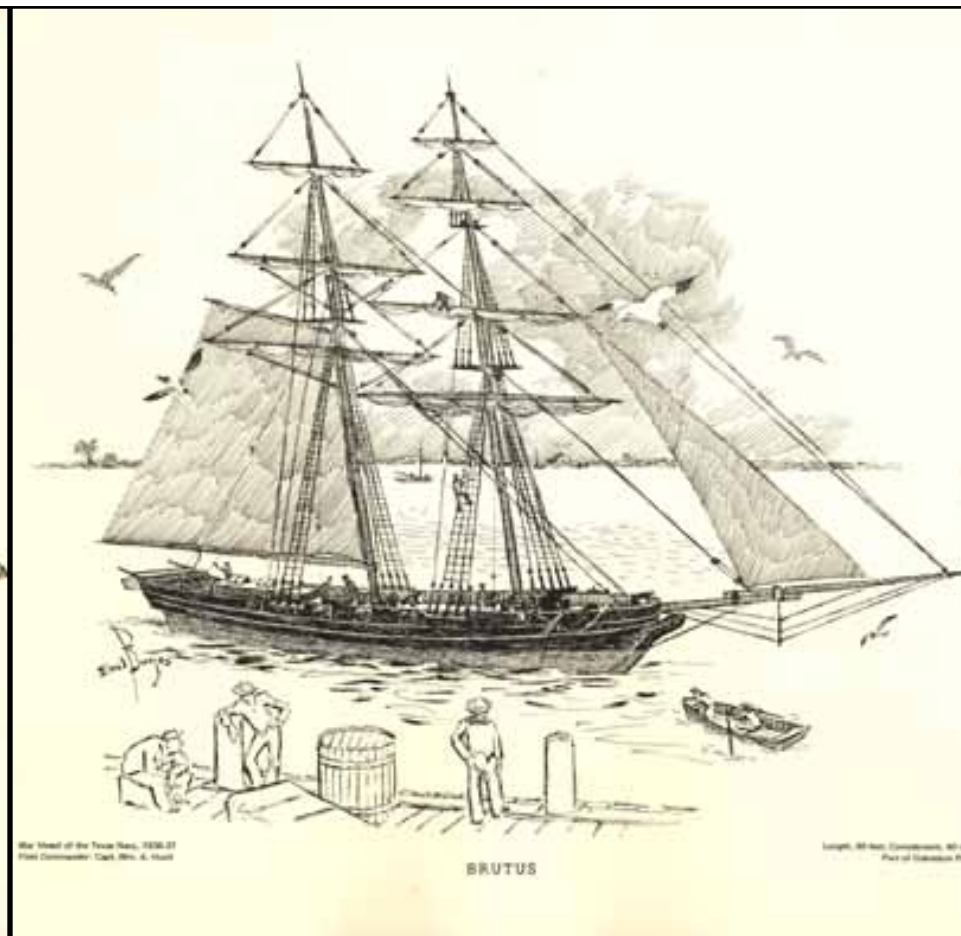

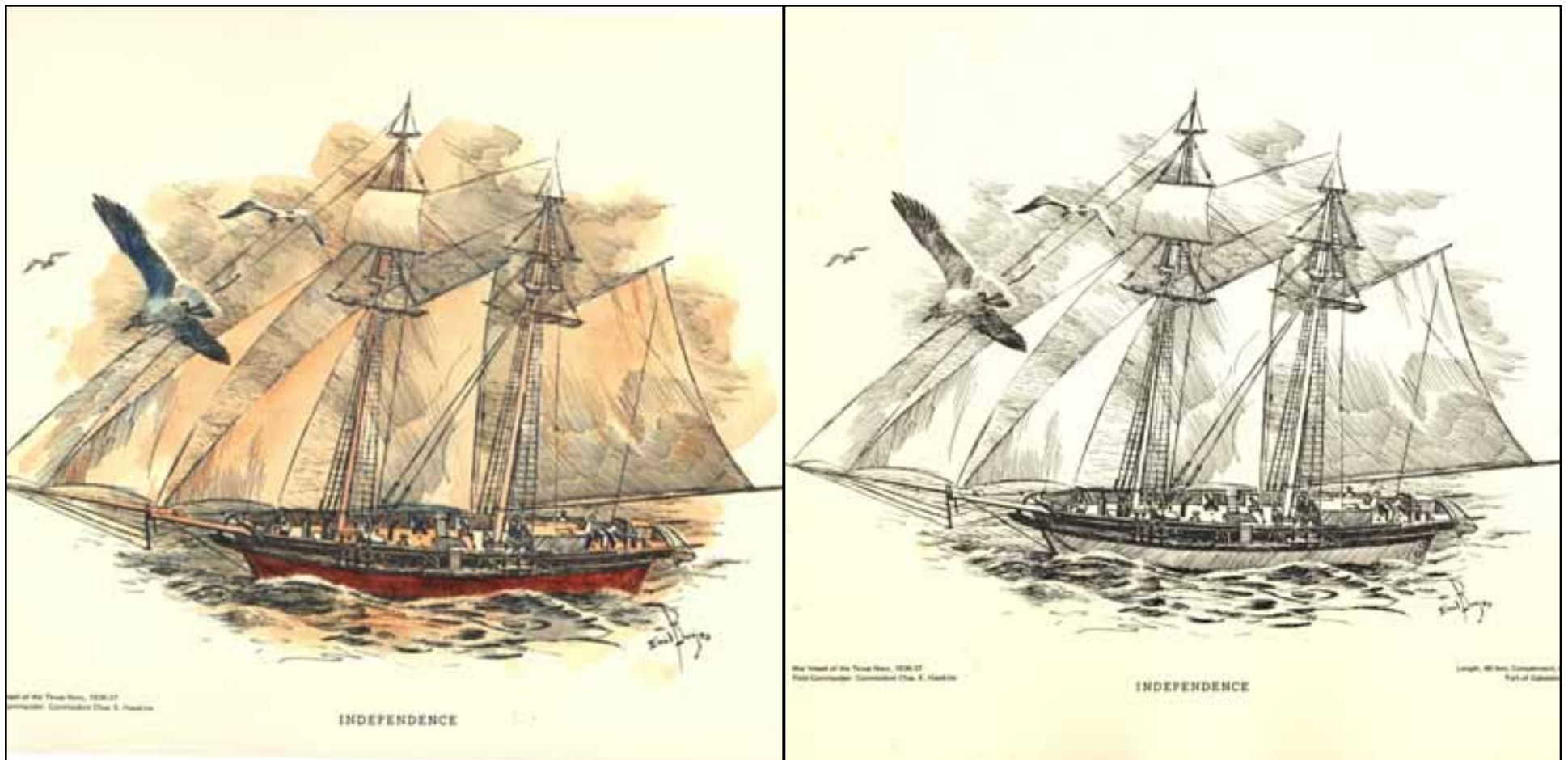

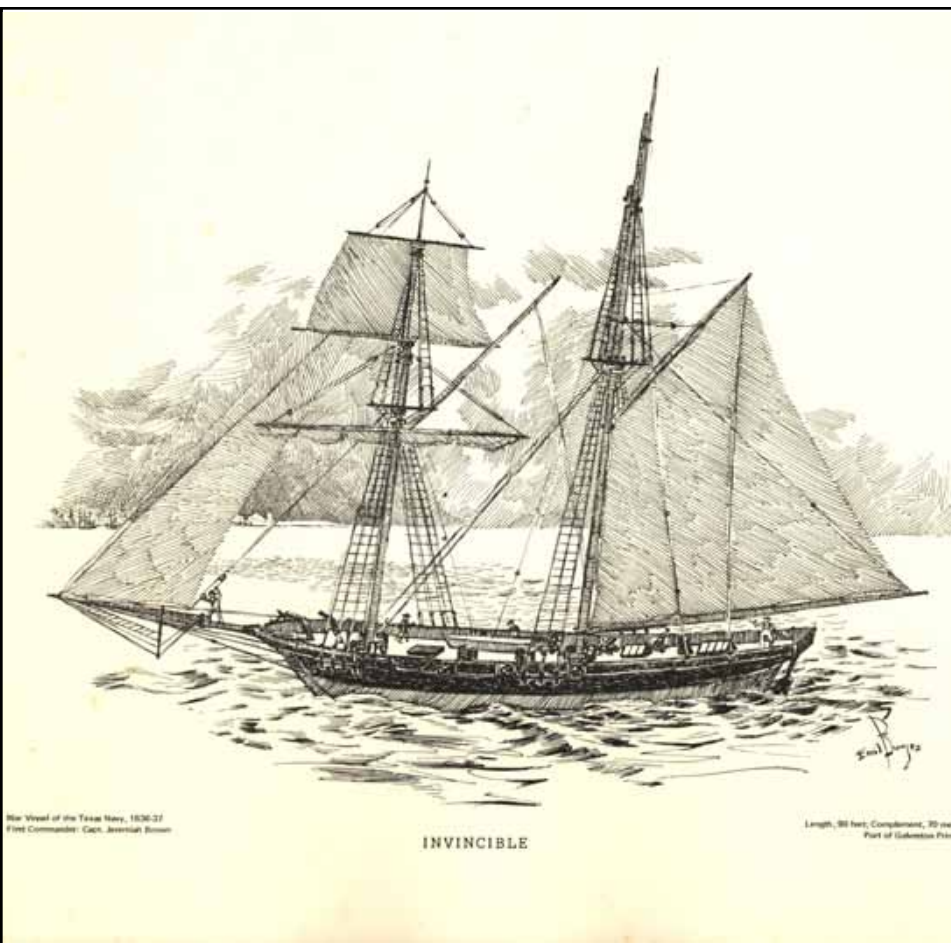

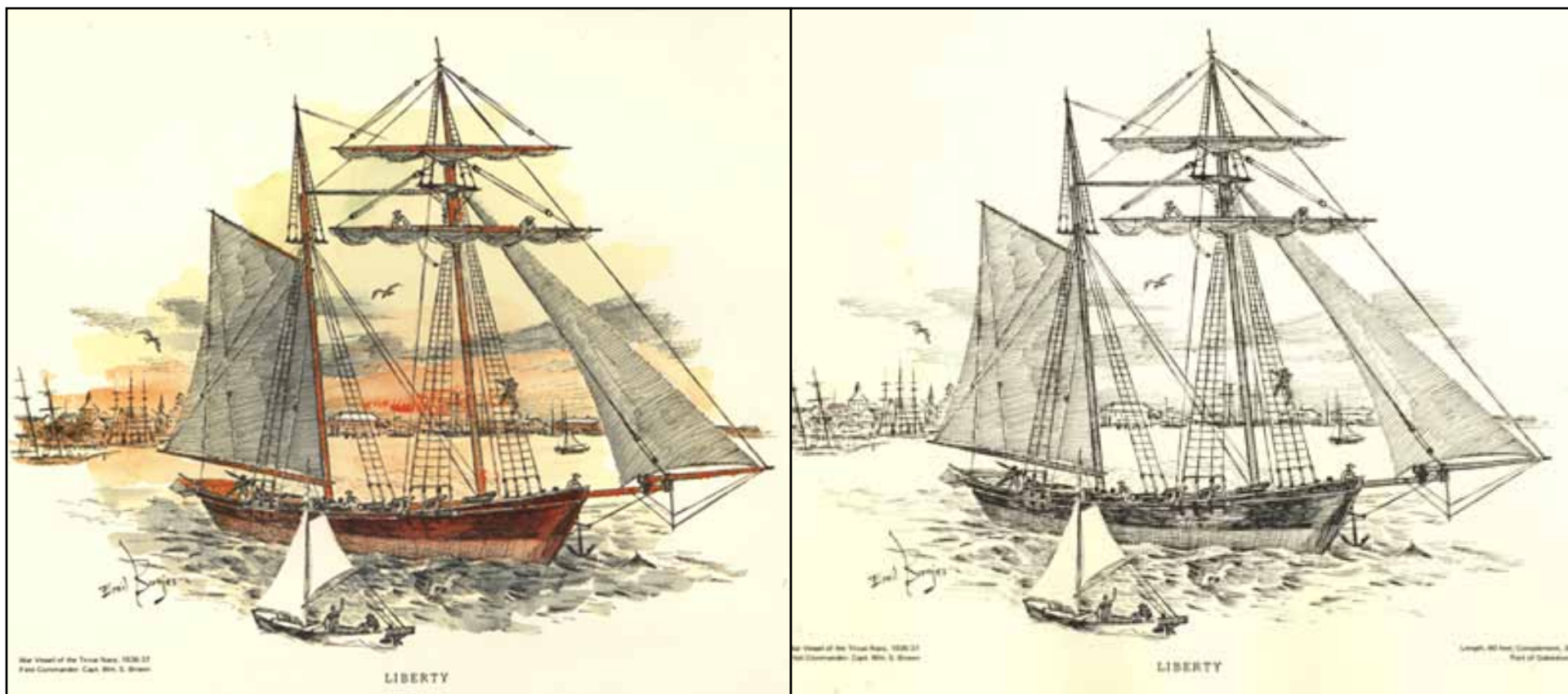
Drawing of the Schooner of War BRUTUS

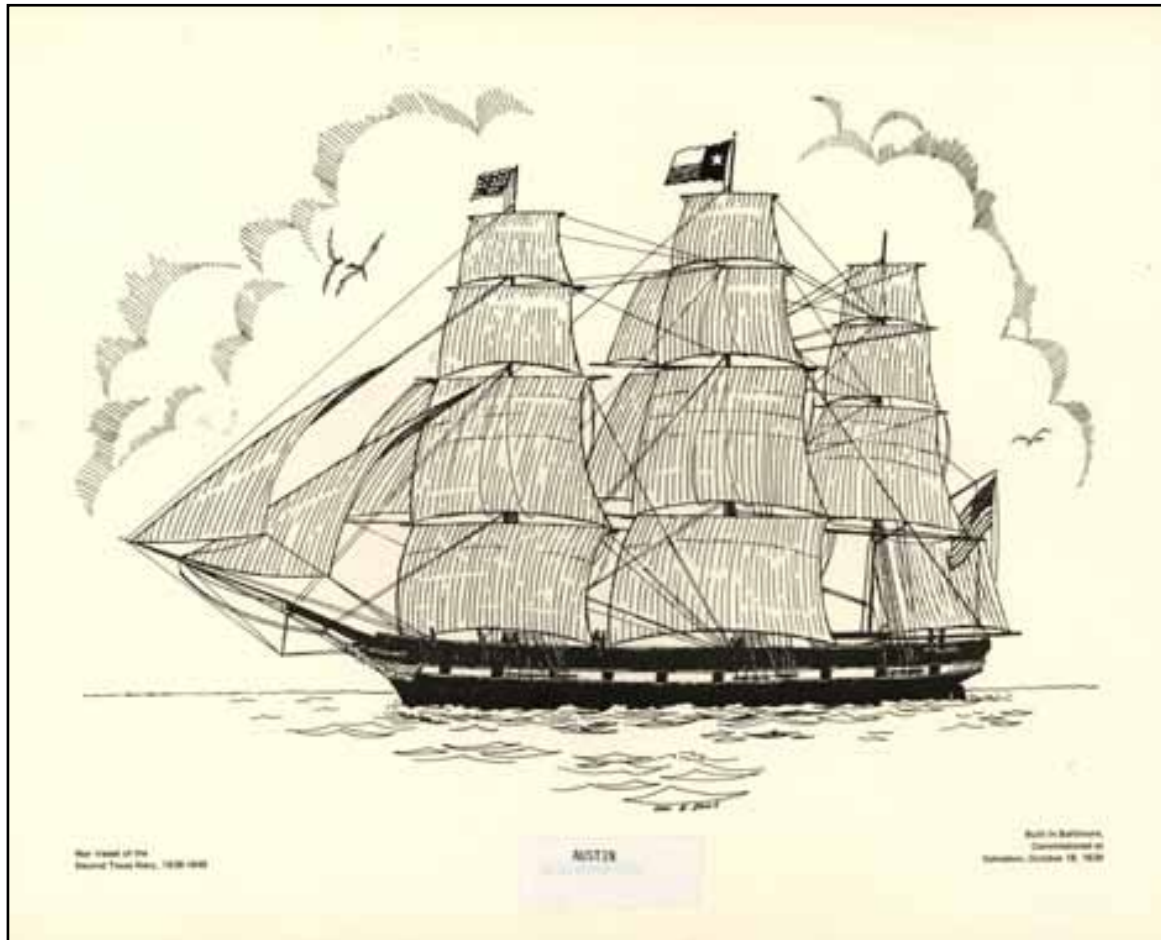
Drawing of the Schooner of War INDEPENDENCE

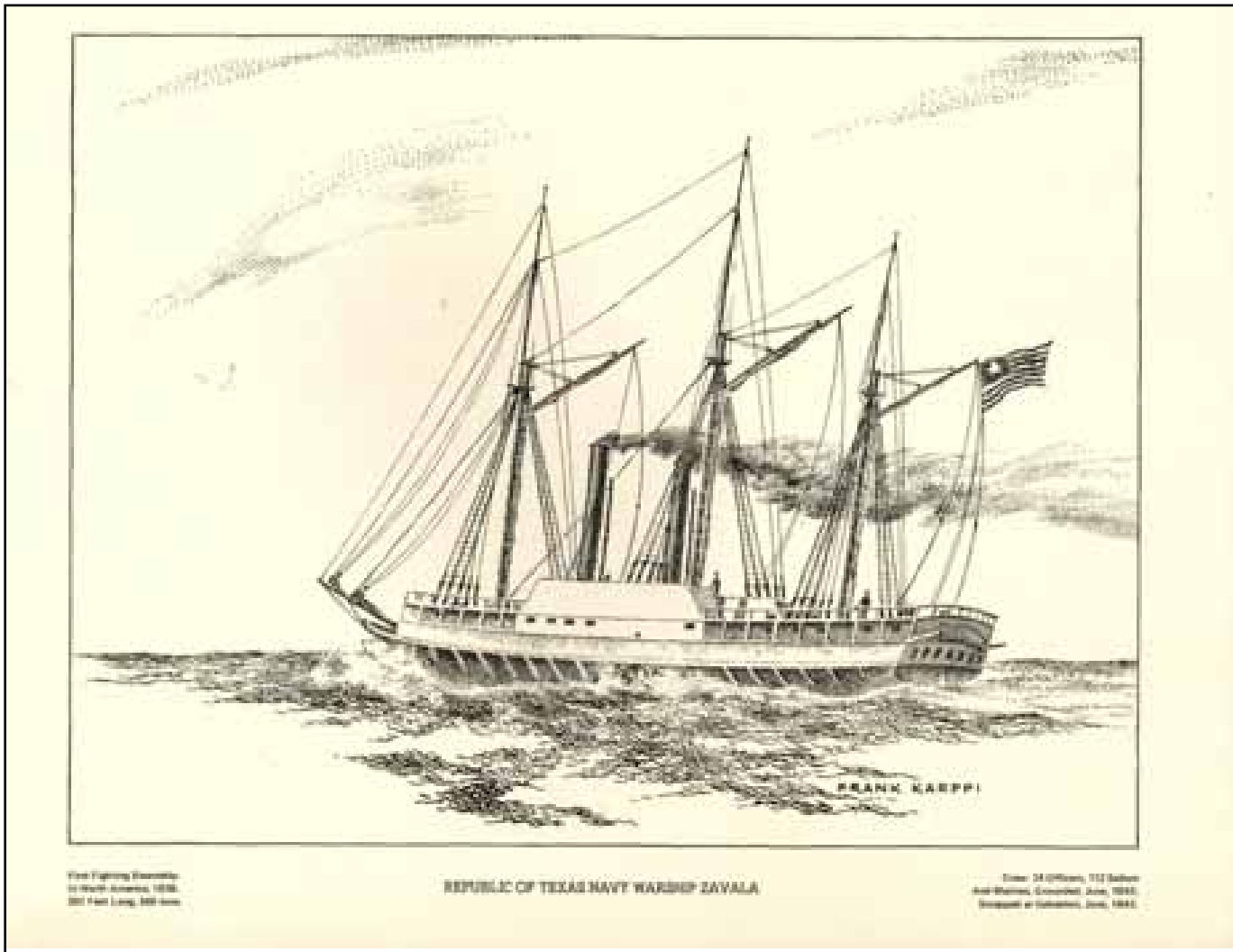
Drawing of the Schooner of War INVINCIBLE

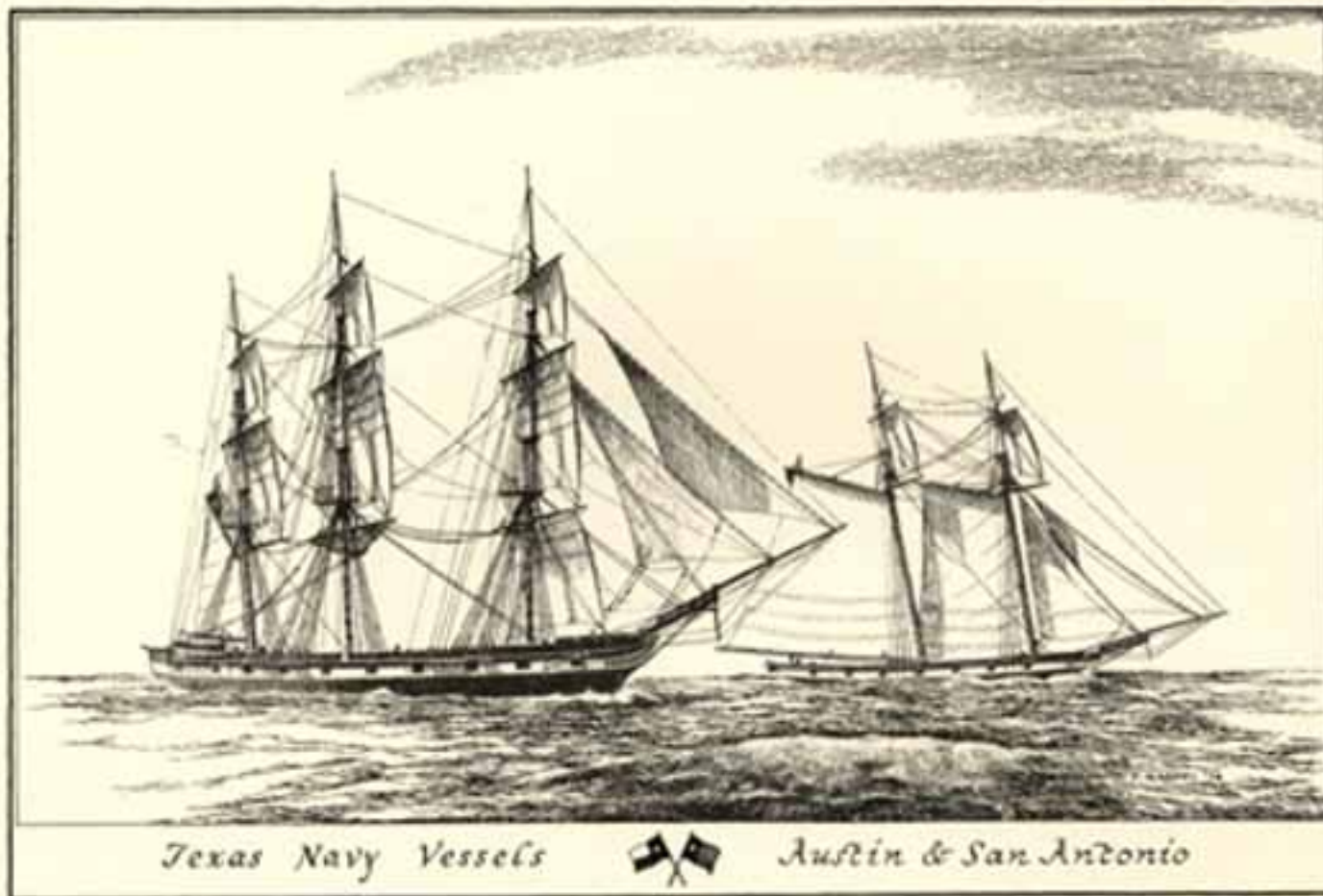

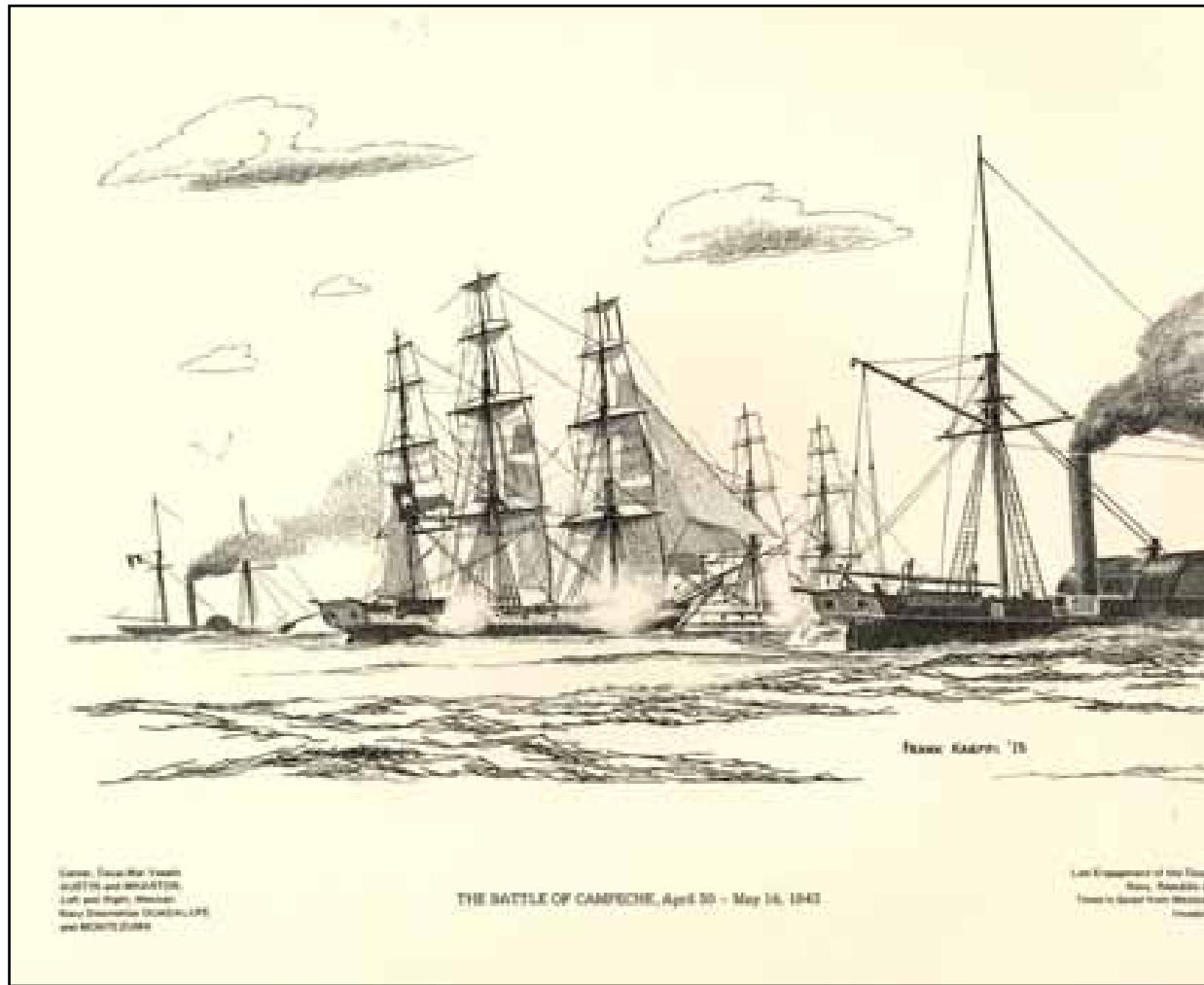


Drawing of the Armed Steamboat ZAVALA

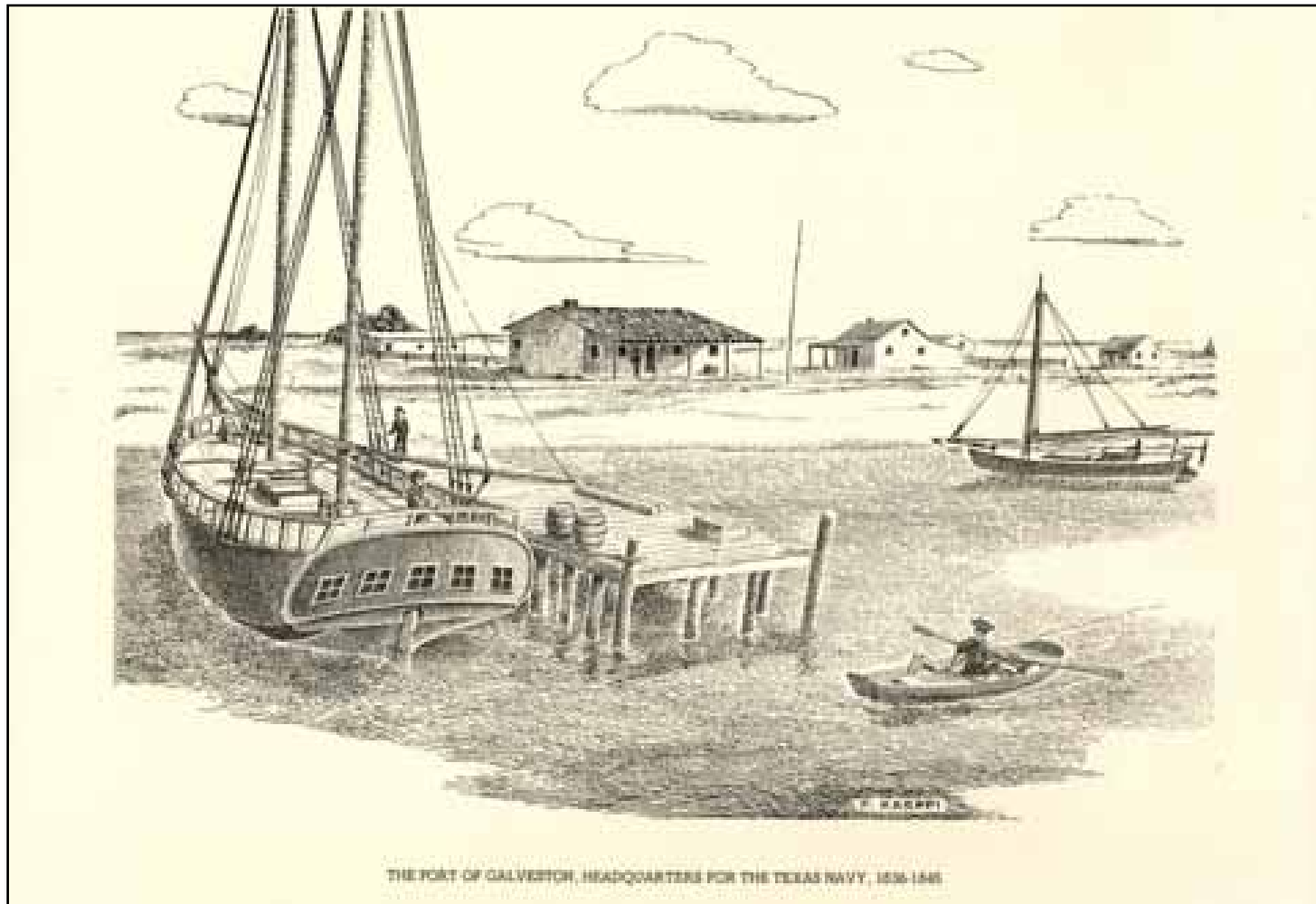


Scene, from the year

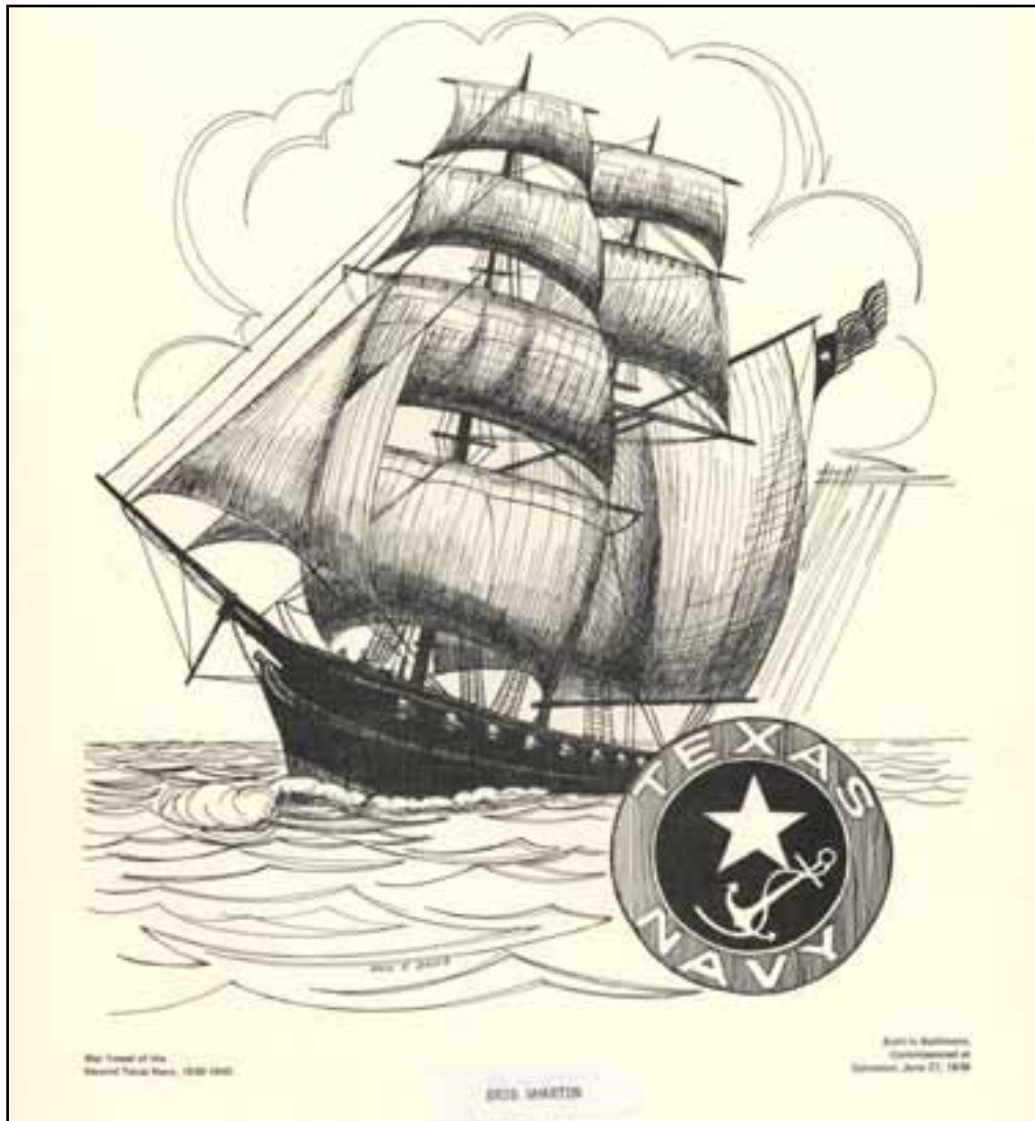
